Position begins August 30th. This position includes teaching classical and jazz trumpet lessons from 3 - 5 hours each week, on either a Monday or Wednesday at our Newberg, Oregon Campus. The instructor will also lead jazz ensemble brass sectionals every other week, and perform with the Faculty Jazz Combo & in Faculty Concerts as desired. Typically, they also fill in as a ringer in the Chehalem Symphony and Symphonic Band, when needed.

Fox students come from a variety of backgrounds and are of many majors, including music majors. Most non-music-majors are taking lessons as part of their music scholarship package, with the goal of improving their performance in Symphonic Band, Orchestra, and/or Jazz Ensemble. Music majors are preparing for juries and recitals.

Pay is \$60/hour.
